

Experience Guidance for Building Surveyors

These Guidelines have been developed by the Registration Body. These Guidelines are intended to provide guidance and clarification on the essential areas of competence required from applicants when demonstrating experience of performing duties commensurate with those of a Building Surveyor.

Experience of performing duties commensurate with those of a Building Surveyor, is described by the Registration Body, as follows:

Employed on a fulltime basis for a minimum of 2 years (or the equivalent on a part-time basis), with appropriate experience in each of the following areas:

- 1. Construction Technology including Building Pathology*
- 2. Building Surveys and Measurement*
- 3. Built Environment Regulatory Framework, such as Building Control Regulations, Building Regulations, Planning Legislation, Health and Safety Regulations.*

OR

Can demonstrate particular specialised relevant experience in any one of these areas with prior experience in the other areas

OR

Possess relevant experience as may be considered appropriate by the Admissions Board.

It is recommended that you provide;

- Name and details of previous employment
- A list of specific projects to demonstrate the appropriate experience
- A detailed description of your personal involvement
- Examples of the scope and range of your experience
- Specific building surveying tasks undertaken
- Any other relevant information
