## Case Reference 160220 - Hearing Date 10th May 2018

The appellant is appealing the decision of a Professional Conduct Committee hearing held on 28<sup>th</sup> April 2017. The Appeal is listed to take place on 10<sup>th</sup> May 2018 at 11am at the offices of the Society of Chartered Surveyors Ireland, 38 Merrion Square, Dublin 2.

The appellant is appealing a determination by a Professional Conduct Committee against a finding that his actions amounted to a breach of the Society of <u>Chartered Surveyors Ireland Members</u> <u>Professional Conduct Rules Monitoring and Investigation Procedures Disciplinary Rule and</u> <u>Procedures</u> Rule 2.1 Ethical and professional behaviour and Rule 2.14 Advertising

## **Appeals Board Decision**

On the 10 May 2018, the Appeals Board of the Society heard two appeals of a member of the Society from determinations of the Professional Conduct Committee dated 10 May 2017 where the Professional Conduct Committee had imposed sanctions for breaches of Rules 2.14 and 2.1. These included the imposition of a reprimand to remain on the Member's file for a 2year period from 10 May 2017; requiring the Member to give an undertaking in relation to his conduct and requiring the Member to pay a fine to the Society. The Appeals Board dismissed the appeal and upheld the findings of Professional Conduct Committee.
